## OVERVIEW OF DATES

- until 16.06.  Register online to have the postal voting ballots sent to you
- until 23.06.  You can pick up the ballots personally with this [document](#) if you forgot to order them
- until 30.06.  Send in your ballots until 18 o'clock this day

## WHAT/WHOM ARE YOU ELECTING? - STUDENT PARLIAMENT, SENATORS, STUDENT COMMITTEES (FACHSCHAFTEN)



**Representatives in the Student Parliament (StuPa):** Issue joint resolutions on university-wide matters (you have 16 votes to divide on different candidates of one political university group with a maximum of 3 votes per candidate).



**Senators:** Student representatives in the University Senate (2 votes for one election proposal list).



**Student Committees** (Student representatives in the Faculty Council): Helping students and representing them in the Faculty Council (2 votes for one election proposal list or 4 votes in case you study at the Faculty of Arts and Humanities).

## STUD.IP COURSE NUMBERS

By signing up to one of the following Stud.IP courses (open until 16.06., 16 o'clock), you will automatically have the postal voting ballots sent to your address. We recommend entering your address under "Zusatzangaben" ("additional information") to make sure that the ballots are sent to the correct place.

## DOUBLE DEGREES AND TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAMMES

Students enrolled in Teacher Education Programmes normally vote at the faculty connected to their main subject. You can, however, vote at the faculty of your minor subject [on request](#).

As soon as you order your postal voting ballots, you cannot vote in person anymore. You have to send them in or put them in the mailbox of the electoral office (Innstraße 41, room VW 305) before 30.06., 18 o'clock.
